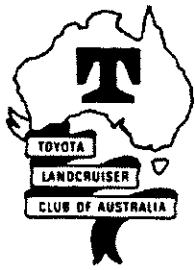

The Toyota Landcruiser Club of Australia (Victoria) Branch is pleased to invite you to the TLC National Conference in September 2007.

Where is it?

The Conference will be held at Rawnsley Park Station in the picturesque Flinders Ranges, just south of Wilpena Pound, South Australia.

When is it?

Arrive Sunday 23rd Sept - Depart Thursday 27th Sept.

The Conference will be held over three days, with registration on Sunday 23rd September. It concludes on Wednesday evening 26th September. (Of course you are welcome to stay at the venue longer if you please).

What facilities are available?

Rawnsley Park Station has a variety of accommodation available, but our conference will officially be at the Rawnsley Park Station Caravan Park.

It has all the facilities which you would expect, including shop, drinking water, showers/ablution blocks, BBQ, laundry, fuel and swimming pool.

The Conference organisers have pre-booked a number of sites (powered and unpowered) for TLC members attending the conference. A 10% discount applies off the accommodation up to 30th June.

What activities are available?

For conference participants (TLC Committee and sub-committee representatives) discussion sessions will occur Monday and Tuesday morning. (Additional time can be allocated if necessary).

For other members a number of four-wheel drive tours have been organised, along with an Aussie Explorer training session, local National Parks Service Ranger speaker, Westprint and perhaps even a sneak preview of the new Toyota 200 Series.

Other activities are still to be confirmed.

Who is invited?

Every financial Toyota Landcruiser Club member in Australia is eligible to attend. While the Conference sessions are scheduled for Club Executives, we would like to see as many TLC members as possible from all over Australia get together and enjoy each others company. While the event is designated as a Conference there is also plenty of time allocated for socialising and enjoying our recreation.
